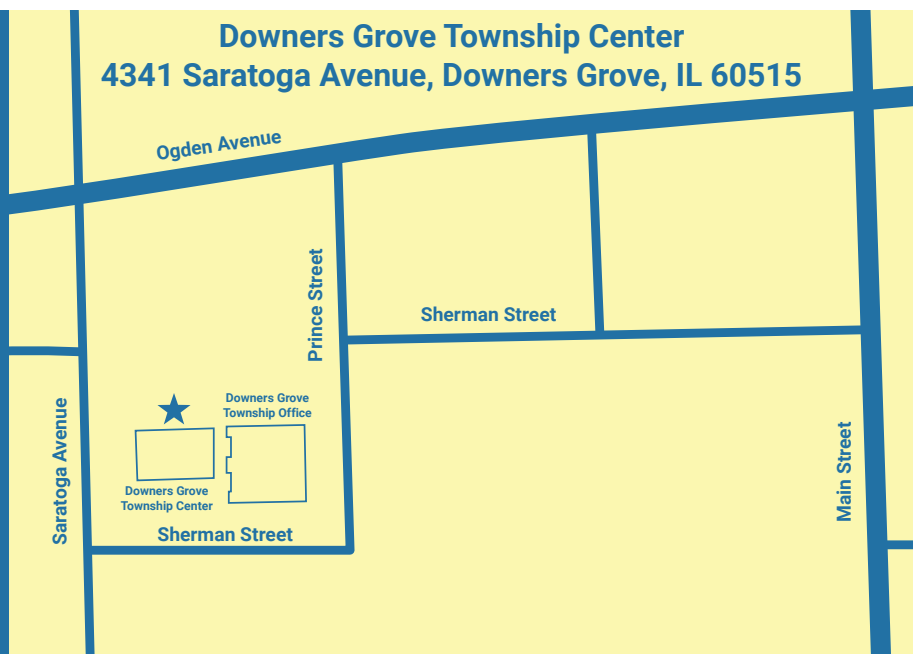

HOW TO REGISTER FOR FEE-BASED ACTIVITIES:

- 1. FIND THE ACTIVITY:** Look for activities marked with a green dollar sign on My Active Center. This indicates they have a nominal fee.
- 2. CHECK THE PRICE:** Once you click on the activity, you'll see the price displayed in green text on the activity page.
- 3. ADD TO CART:** Click "Add to Cart" to proceed. The subtotal will be shown.
- 4. GO TO YOUR CART:** Open your cart to review your selection. Here, you can click the green box that says "Pay for Selected Items."
- 5. ENTER PAYMENT INFORMATION:** A pop-up will appear where you can enter your credit card details.
- 6. CONFIRM PAYMENT:** After entering your payment information, your receipt will be displayed.
- 7. OPTIONS AFTER PAYMENT:** From the receipt screen, you can:
 - Print your receipt.
 - View your schedule.
 - Return to browsing for more activities.
- 8. CALL THE TOWNSHIP** at 630-719-6670 if unable to register on My Active Center for assistance in registering for Fee-Based Activities.

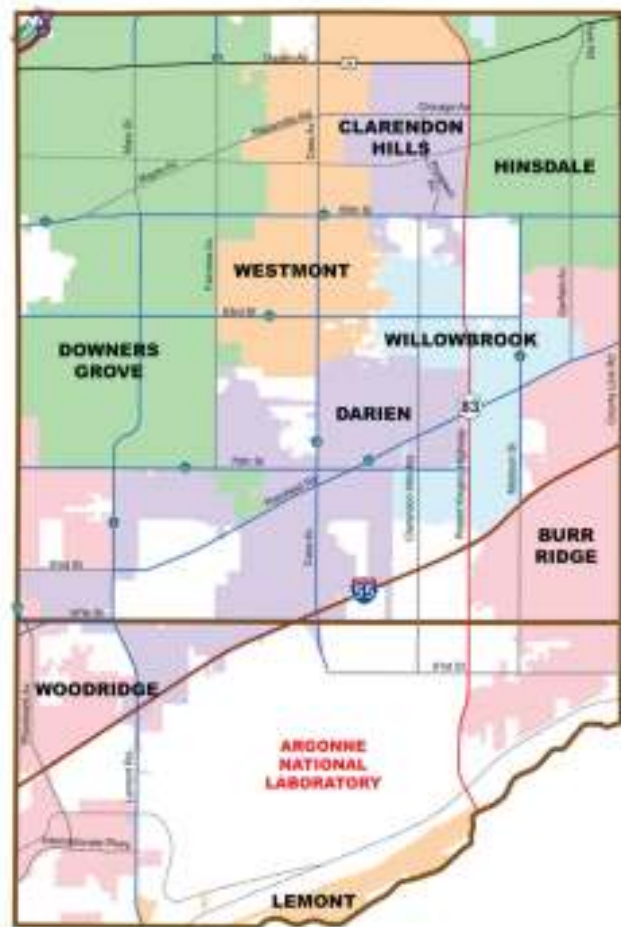
